# 4.1. Description of first aid measures

#### After inhalation

Ensure supply of fresh air. In the event of symptoms take medical treatment.

## After skin contact

Wash off immediately with soap and water.

In case of contact with the eyes rinse thoroughly with plenty of water or with an eye-cleaning solution. Seek medical advice immediately.
